## NEW CODE OF CONTRACT Legislative Decree 50/2016

# CAM and D.Lgs 50/2016 NEW CODE OF CONTRACT: the relevant elements Art. 34, Comma 2

# CAM (Minimum Environmental Criteria) applicable to the full tender value (100 %)

- a) Public lighting
- b) Electrical and electronic office equipment
- c) Energy services for cooling heating building
- d) Appointment of design service and works for new construction, renovation and maintenance of buildings and for the management of PA construction sites (CAM Building)

CAM applicable to at least 50% of the value of the tender (100% by 2020)

DM 24 May 2016

- a) Cleaning services, even where provided in global service contracts, and supplies of hygiene products such as cleaning detergents
- b) Services of public green management and supplies of amendments, ornamental plants and irrigation systems
- c) Waste management services
- d) Supplies of urban furniture items
- e) Paper and paper supplies





## CAM-BUILDING Legislative Decree 15 December 2015, n. 222

- Minimum Environmental Criteria for relying on the design service for the new construction, renovation and maintenance of buildings and for the design and management of the construction sites
- The CAM Building is an integral part of the PAN GPP "Action Plan for Environmental Sustainability of PA Consumption" (adopted by the Interministerial Decree of 11-4-2008 and updated with Decree 10-04-2013)
- National GPP p.4 to 4.2 "national target": to achieve by 2015 the share of 50% of 'green procurement' on the total of contracts awarded (assessed on the number and value);
- The PAN GPP contributes to the achievement of the national energy saving target (Article 3 of Legislative Decree 102 of 4/7/14);

# Legislative Decree 15 December 2015, n. 222 (Annex 1 updated on 28-1-2017)

#### 2.4.2 Specific criteria for building components

Concretes used for the project must be produced with a minimum content of recycled (dry) material of at least 5% on the weight of the product (as the sum of the individua components).
For the purpose of calculating the mass of recycled material, the amount actually remaining in the final product should be considered.
The designer must specify the environmental profile information of the selected product and must prescribe that the contractor must ensure that the contract is met in the procurement phase.
The percentage of recycled material must be demonstrated by means of one of the following options:
Environmental Type III Declaration, complying with UNI EN 15804 and ISO 14025;
A product certification issued by a conformity assessment body certifying recycled content such as Remade in Italy®, or equivalent;
<ul> <li>An environmental self-declaration of type II conforming to ISO 14021, verified by a conformity assessment body.</li> </ul>

- The conformity assessment body that intends to issue certifications is the one accredited to UNI CEI EN ISO / IEC 17000 (17065, 17021, 17024).
- A conformity assessment body that intends to carry out verification requirements is the one accredited to UNI CEI EN ISO / IEC 17020 standards.
